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Please return the completed form to the County Co-ordinator together with a cheque for £30 made payable to **Bowls Kent Coaching Association** (this includes a manual for Level 1 and 2 [Foundation and Club Coach] and a cloth badge). On completion of Foundation Level 1, a £9 fee is payable for registration (inclusive of insurance) as a coach with the EBCS. For those not continuing to Level 2 and require only a Level 1 certificate a £14 fee is required. The fee covers registration for the first year up to 30<sup>th</sup> September. Certification for Club Coach (after passing the Club Coach examination) requires a further fee of £5. Thereafter you must renew your registration of £9 annually (to the County Coordinator) and submit a copy of your log book to ensure your continued licence as an accredited coach.
