Please return the completed form to the County Co-ordinator together with a cheque for £40 made payable to **Bowls Kent Coaching Association** (this includes a manual for Level 1 and 2 and a Foundation or Club Coach cloth badge and a copy of the Laws of the Sport). On completion of Foundation Level 1, a £6.00 fee is payable for registration (inclusive of insurance) as a coach with the EBCS. For those not continuing to Level 2 and require a Level 1 certificate a £11 fee is required. The fee covers. your registration for the first year up to 30<sup>th</sup> September. Certification for Club (after passing the level 2 Club Coach examination) requires a further fee of £5.00. Thereafter you must renew your **EBCS** registration of £6 annually. You may be asked to submit a copy of your logbook (to the County Co-ordinator) to ensure your continued licence as an accredited coach.
